



Materials:

- Heavy paper, such as card stock (a paper plate works too!)
- Liquid glue (white glue)
- Water colors
- Salt
- Water
- Newspaper/tablecloth/pan

Instructions:

1. Spread a sheet of newspaper or a tablecloth over your work area. Or, you can use a sheet pan!
2. On your card stock or paper plate, you can lightly pencil a design. Then carefully trace your design in white glue. You can also freehand a design in glue - that's what I did! Then, totally cover the glue in salt. Gently tap the excess off. You're ready to paint!
3. Using your water colors, get the brush really wet. Gently dab color onto the salt - don't use brush strokes, since the glue is still wet! Watch how the salt pulls the color through, and how the colors mix together where they meet.
