

HOW TO USE ERC DATABASES

1. Visit the ERC webpage: <http://www.youseemore.com/ccua/>
2. Select the tab “ERC Databases”



3. Use the drop-down menu to select “Online Databases”



4. Your Patron ID Number is the 14-digit number on your student ID that is located under the barcode. (Faculty will need to contact the ERC to set up an account.) Your PIN is your 5-digit student ID number. (Patron IDs are defaulted to last one year. If your ID is not working, contact the ERC to extend the period of use.) ***DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE WEEKEND TO CHECK WHETHER YOU’RE ABLE TO LOG IN.**

Note: Your patron ID is your entire 14 digit library barcode.

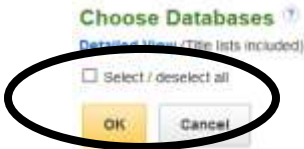
Note: Student PIN # is your Student ID#, all others use the last 5 digits of your library barcode.

5. After submitting your log in request, you’ll see a list of databases available through the ERC. There are approximately 170 databases available including the resources through the Arkansas Traveler Portal. Select a database and start researching.

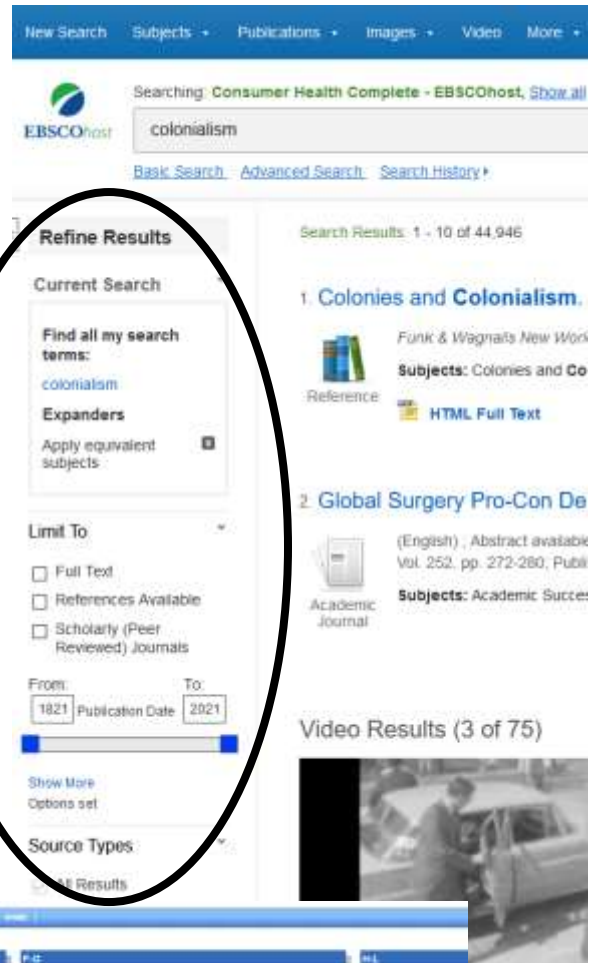
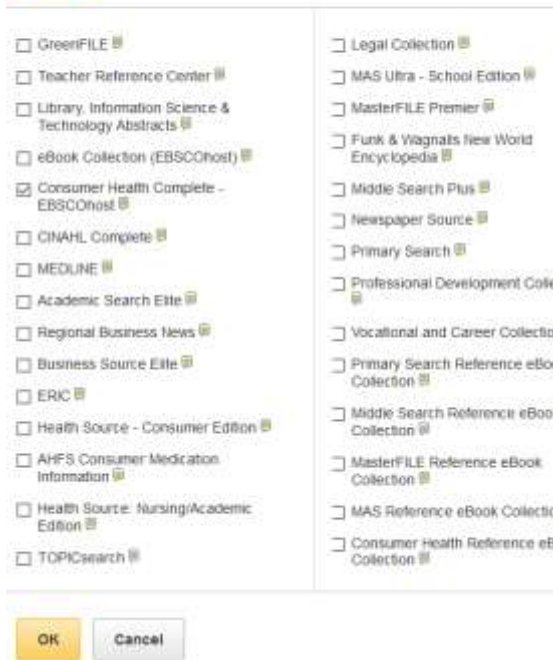
6. Several databases are provided through EBSCO. To search all of the EBSCO databases at once: Select “Consumer Health Complete-EBSCOhost.” When the Search bar appears, select “Choose Databases.”

7. You will see a list of all the EBSCOhost databases available. Check the box that says “Select/deselect all.” Then select “OK” at the bottom left.



8. Searching the term “colonialism” yielded almost 45,000 results. Use the search parameters at the left to narrow results.
