We are continuing to show lots of movies at all of the locations of the Greenup County system. There is no admission charged for these movies. The only fees involved are for refreshments.

For the "Month of Mayberry" in September please refer to the article on page 1 for the list of the movies, days and times for both Flatwoods and Greenup.

The following movies are what are playing at Greenup. For the "Month of Disney" we are having in October the line up is as follows. Oct. 5th "The Rescuers" at 1:00 and "The Rescuers Down Under" at 3:00. On the 17th is "Pirate Day" and we are showing "Dead Man's Chest" at 12:00 and "At World's End" at 3:00. "Monsters vs. Aliens" on Oct. 8th at 5:00. On the 23rd of Oct. we are having "Fright Night". The movies for this are rated R for violence & language with no nudity. You must be 18 or over you must have a picture ID. Those under 18 will only be admitted with an adult. The lineup for the 23rd is at 6:00 "Wrong Turn" and 8:00 "Quarantine". Since there are two movies on this day pizza will also be for sale. On Oct. 24th will be a Halloween Event. The lineup is "Igor" at 1:00 and "The Nightmare Before Christmas" at 3:00. Come in costume if you want. Events are planned for this day so call the Greenup Library for more information.

We will sell hotdogs and nachos on the days with two movies except for the 23rd when pizza will be sold. GENEALOGY CORNER, KATHLEEN VIRGIN KENNEY, GENEALOGY LIBRARIAN

Genealogy staff and volunteers made a research trip to Whitesburg, Kentucky, Wise County, Russell County, and Taswell County, Virginia in July. Fifteen books on County Court Records for Floyd, Lawrence, Morgan, Perry, and Pike counties were purchased. The following family history books have been added to our collection: Allen-Gray, Barnes, Barber, Counts, Dempsey, Hinkson, Lewis, O'Neal, Salley, Spears, and Whitt.

On Friday, August 21, Sarah Milligan from the Kentucky Historical Society in Frankfort conducted a Veteran Oral History Interview Training class. During September and October, veterans will be interviewed from WWII to the present. User copies will be on deposited for local access with our library. This will allow us to do in-house circulation. The individuals interviewed will get copies of their interviews for their own use and a copy will be sent to the Library of Congress' Veteran's History project for national level access.

McKell Story Hour will be on Tuesday and begins Tuesday September 15th at

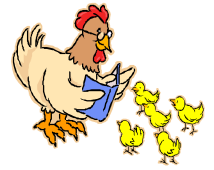

All of the libraries are closed on Sunday. The libraries will be closed Monday September 7 for Labor Day and November 26 for Thanksgiving Day.

The Greenup County Public Library System is the best value for your money during these hard economic times. Read the latest best sellers in large print, regular print, or audio CD's. You can also check out movies or place a hold for a book on our website or call one of the library locations to place a hold. A call to the patron will be placed to inform them of the arrived hold. Each location in the system, except for the bookmobile, has public access computers. You must have your library card with you to be able to check items out or to use the computers. Wi-Fi (wireless internet) is also available. Anyone needing internet service can stop by the library. These services are all FREE!!

The libraries also have a notary, color copier and faxing services. These are offered for a small fee. If you have any questions about these services please contact your local library.

There are community meeting rooms available by reservation at all locations for clubs and organizations but not for private parties.
