There is often a regression in academic proficiency that hinders progress in the following school year, with a recent study by the Northwest Evaluation Association showing, on average, a 20% loss from school-year gains. This so-called "summer slide" puts younger children at most risk as they are at a crucial stage in their development. The SRP engages kids and their interests' so that their letter knowledge, decoding, and word reading skills continue to develop, rather than stagnate or decline. Each week, the NPL's Main Branch and Northeast Branch in Campti will offer performances for children.

Saturday, June 4, will also be the final day to shop the Friends of the NPL mini book sale! Additionally, LifeShare will be onsite from 10 AM to 2 PM for patrons to donate blood and receive a special treat from The Cakery.
