This is a fun craft for when it's a nice day outside!

Do you believe there are aliens somewhere out there in space?

What do you think they'd look like if you saw one? Would they like pizza? How many eyes would they have? What would they drive? We're making the vehicle that gets them to earth. Their flying saucer!

Materials:

- 2 Paper Plates
- Clear Packing Tape
(scotch tape can also be used; it just takes longer!)
- Scissors

Optional:

- Markers
- Stickers
- Crayons, etc.

Directions:

1. Decorate the outside and inside edges of your paper plates.
2. Cover the inside and outside of both plates with packing tape or scotch tape. (This takes a while. Be patient and make sure everything is covered. It's fine to overlap the tape a little.)
3. Cut out the inside circle of each plate.
4. Tape the cut parts in the edge back together.
5. Stack the plates on top of each other like a clam shell. Tape around the edges.
6. Go Outside and Try Out Your Flying Saucer!
