## Ingredients:

- File Folders
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Scotch Tape
- Markers (or crayons)

## OPTIONAL:

- Template
- Bendy Straw



## Directions:

1. Keeping the file folder closed, cut it horizontally into 2-3 inch strips.
2. Using the pencil, trace a mustache template from the next page (or draw your own) onto the strip. The center part of the mustache should go against the folded edge of the folder.
3. Cut out the mustache. Make sure to cut both sides of the folder, but **DO NOT** cut the center portion of the mustache.
4. Unfold. You should have a complete mustache shape.
5. Color in the mustache with markers or crayons.
6. Turn the mustache over and tape the top part of the pencil to either the right, left or middle of the mustache. (You can use an unsharpened pencil for this part).

## Bendy Straw Variation:

Use a bendy straw in place of the pencil! When kids take a sip, they'll look like they have a mustache.

1. Bend the top of the straw.
2. Tape the bent part of the straw to the **CENTER** and **BOTTOM** of the mustache.
