Directions:

1. Using crayons, draw a picture on the sandpaper.
2. Color and cut out shapes and designs from the sandpaper.
3. Attach the shapes with glue or double stick tape.
4. Attach seashells, rocks, glitter, beads, or any other decorations you'd like.

Tip:

Use thick double stick tape for a cool 3-D effect.
